GDPR REGULATIONS: INFORMATION ABOUT DATA COLLECTION AND PRIVACY POLICY

In line with the new regulations, this document sets out the data I collect and why, how it is stored, what I do with it and how you can access/ remove this information.

Science Geek Workshop is a not-for-profit organisation owned and run by:

Science Geek workshops began in September 2013. I am a registered STEM ambassador offering science badge workshops, science shows and interactive workshops / events with uniformed organisations in the North West

As part of my regular activities, I collect workshop users information which will include contact names and therefore, be identifiable. This information is password protected and kept on a secure machine which is backed up on a hard drive and in the cloud. A paper copy is also kept in a filing cabinet. All paper information will be shredded after 7 years.

As part of my offering, I send out an electronic newsletter once a quarter using an opt in subscriber list. Occasionally, I may contact this list for special news and marketing offers. The only information I have from this list are email addresses which are kept in a password protected file, on a secure machine backed up on a hard drive and in the cloud the cloud. Everyone on this list can contact me to ask to be removed and all information will be deleted.

It is possible to download the newsletter from our website without subscribing, so there is no detrimental effect to not signing up.

We do not share data with anyone else and we do not buy in information from external companies.

In line with most websites, <https://sciencegeekworkshop.yolasite.com/> uses simple cookies and analytics to track the number of visitors but I do not use Google analytics to track, record or identify visitors and as far as is within our control I do not allow Google access to that information.

The science geek website has a simple visitor counter cookie that does not track or identify.
